MOTION FOR BRIEF EXTENSION OF TIME

The Association for Maximum Service Television, Inc. (“MSTV”) respectfully requests a brief extension of four business days for the public to comment on the recently-filed TV band device database manager proposals. As discussed below, moving the comment deadline to February 9, 2010, and the reply comment deadline to February 24, 2010, will serve the public interest by ensuring a more reliable and informed database manager selection process.

Nine entities submitted TV band device database manager proposals to the Commission by January 4, 2010.¹ These proposals constitute over 600 pages of information, much of which is highly technical, explaining, for example, the applicant’s technical expertise, the scope of the database functions, detailed descriptions of how the database will operate, and the methods that will be used to enable communications between TV band devices and the database. Since the proposals were filed, MSTV has reviewed the proposals and has been in contact with some of the applicants in order to obtain additional information and clarification regarding certain aspects of their proposals. These discussions have been productive.
