This letter provides notice that on January 28, 2010, Peggy Binzel and Jaime Harrison of The Podesta Group and Jennifer McCarthy of NextWave Wireless Inc. met with Louis Peraertz, Legal Advisor to Commissioner Mignon Clyburn, regarding the above captioned proceedings in which changes are proposed to the technical rules governing both SDARS and WCS to enable coexistence of the two services.

The parties discussed the importance of bringing the WCS-SDARS rulemaking proceeding to a conclusion as quickly as possible to enable WCS licensees, including NextWave and its operating partners DigitalBridge Communications and NRTC, to move forward with deployments and meet the WCS substantial service obligations by July of 2010. Final rules also are needed before the vendor community will meaningfully invest in the WCS band. Echoing the message imparted in recent Congressional letters to Chairman Genachowski, resolution of the WCS-SDARS rulemaking will appreciably increase the spectrum available to build out high-speed broadband infrastructure to unserved and underserved areas, thereby helping the Commission achieve its objective of ensuring every American has access to broadband capability.
