This letter is to inform you that on January 28, 2010, Sprint Nextel Corporation (“Sprint”), through its representatives Charles W. McKee and Maria Cattafesta, met with Ruth Milkman, James Schlichting, and Paul Murray of the Wireless Telecommunications Bureau regarding the above-referenced proceedings.

Sprint reiterated its support for the permanent elimination of the in-market exception to the automatic roaming requirement. The parties also reviewed and discussed the roaming data Sprint submitted in its *ex parte* filing of January 20, 2010 in WT Docket No. 05-265. In addition, Sprint underscored the urgent need for special access reform consistent with its filings in WC Docket No. 05-25.
