
**Re: ET Docket No. 04-186 Unlicensed Operation in the TV Broadcast Bands**

Dear Ms. Dortch:

Micronet Communications, Inc. (Micronet) was selected as a database manager for the 70/90 GHz Services<sup>1</sup>, giving Micronet the expertise to establish a database management service. Micronet did not apply to become a database administrator for TV Band Unlicensed Operations, but is following the developments with interest.

Our experience to date indicates that selection of multiple Database Managers under the current docket will best serve the public interest, keeping pricing and quality competitive. Given that applications have been received from multiple highly capable entities such as Google, Telcordia, Frequency Finders, etc., Micronet urges the Commission to select at least three of these organizations as TV Band Database Managers.
