This letter is to advise you, in accordance with Section 1.1206(b) of the Commission's rules, that on January 29, 2010, Ben Scott of Free Press met with Blair Levin of the National Broadband Task Force.

In the meeting, I reviewed the major arguments in the Reply Comments filed by Free Press in Public Notice #30 in the National Broadband Plan. I emphasized the importance of a strong competition policy that includes market analyses and triggers for policy interventions to correct market failure. In addition, I reviewed our proposal for transitioning the Universal Service Fund to broadband. I also highlighted the importance of reforming the agency's data collection practices, its disclosure rules, and consumer protections. The details of my presentation were consistent with our previous filed comments.
