COMMENTS

Nave Broadcasting, LLC ("Nave"), by its counsel and pursuant to Section 1.415 of the Commission's Rules, hereby submits these comments in response to the *Notice of Proposed Rule Making*, DA 09-2605 (rel. December 18, 2009), issued in the above-captioned rulemaking proceedings.

Nave states its interest in and support of the proposed allotment of Channel 5 to Seaford, Delaware. The proposed allotment should be adopted as it will serve the public interest by providing the community of Seaford with an additional television service and its first commercial allotment and the State of Delaware with its first very high frequency commercial television station allotment. If the proposed allotment is adopted, Nave intends to apply to participate in the auction for the channel and, if it is the successful bidder, to promptly construct the station after grant.


