Dear Ms. Dortch:

On February 2, 2010, Terrence Smith of Sirius XM Radio Inc. met with Julius Knapp, Chief of the Office of Engineering and Technology, to discuss previously filed positions concerning the rules for 2.3 GHz Wireless Communications Services (“WCS”) and satellite radio service.

Mr. Smith expressed Sirius XM’s fundamental position that the introduction of mobile broadband service in the WCS band requires detailed operating parameters and usage restrictions that protect Sirius XM’s 35 million listeners. Mr. Smith focused his discussion on Sirius XM’s recommendations related to: 1) guard bands; 2) WCS out-of-band emissions limits; and 3) WCS duty cycle limits. Sirius XM’s recommendations on these parameters have been previously submitted into the record.¹
