Dear Ms. Dortch:

On Monday, February 8, 2010, Lowell McAdam, President and CEO of Verizon Wireless, Tom Tauke, Executive Vice President, Public Affairs, Policy and Communications of Verizon Communications Inc., and Steve Zipperstein, General Counsel of Verizon Wireless met with Chairman Genachowski and Chief of Staff Edward Lazarus. During the meeting there was a general discussion of the Broadband Plan, Verizon Wireless's deployment of 4G service using LTE technology, and how wireless networks can contribute to the availability and affordability of broadband services for consumers. Mr. McAdam also raised the pending divestiture transactions involving the former Alltel properties that the Commission had ordered to be sold as a condition of its approval of Verizon Wireless' acquisition of Alltel. Mr. McAdam asked that the Commission expedite its review of these pending transactions, as they have been pending for more than seven months. The positions expressed were consistent with the company's prior filings in these proceedings.
