On February 4, 2010, representatives of the Telecommunications Industry Association (“TIA”) met with Elizabeth Lyle, Attorney Advisor, Broadband Team office to discuss the above mentioned proceeding and accessibility issues relating to the FCC’s National Broadband Plan. Present on behalf of TIA were the following individuals: Mary Brooner, TIA; Rebecca Schwartz, TIA.

At the meeting, TIA discussed the role of accessibility, particularly the effects on adoption, in the National Broadband Plan. TIA reiterated its support for increased government coordination in this area and the role of voluntary industry efforts and standards.
