Dear Chairman Genachowski:

I am the production director for a House of Worship which produces a weekly national television program consisting of music and spoken word. I am writing to you asking for the protection of wireless microphones from interference and to ensure that myself and all other wireless microphone users will be eligible for licenses.

We use an array of wireless technology. We have 35 wireless microphones on our campus as well as four wireless intercom systems and ten wireless in-ear monitors. End users will be one of our pastors, musicians, vocalists or technical associates. We use these tools for broadcast performances produced for weekly national programs, as well as an international radio programs that run every day.


Our message is used to encourage people around the world and to spread the gospel of Jesus Christ.

Since we are a professional broadcast house as well as a House of Worship, it is essential that we have crystal clear sound. We cannot afford to have interference from wireless frequencies that will distract our live audience as well as ruin our recorded messages and music that is later broadcast across the country.

I am asking that any rule changes the FCC adopts will allow Shadow Mountain Community church to obtain an FCC wireless microphone license and continue using our wireless technology as we are and allow for growth into new technology.
