During this meeting, BT discussed the UK regulatory model and its impact on competition and net neutrality in the UK. BT also discussed its investment in fiber and next generation access in the UK. BT commended the FCC for moving forward on analyzing the U.S. special access market and discussed the importance of data collection and change based on evidence. BT also expressed its concerns about the USF contribution mechanism in the U.S. and stressed the need for clarity for both providers and end customers.
