Amendment of Parts 15, 74, and 90 of the Commission's Rules Regarding Low Power
Auxiliary Stations, Including Wireless Microphones
WT Docket Nos. 08-166, 08-167; ET Docket No. 10-24

Dear Chairman Genachowski:

Central Christian Church is a large church located in Mesa, Arizona – just east of Phoenix. We are asking the FCC to protect wireless microphones from interference and ensure that wireless microphone users will be eligible for licenses. On our three current campuses we utilize wireless microphones, intercoms, in-ear monitors by all of our musicians, vocalists, pastors, teachers, actors, and production crews. We record the services in all venues for distribution via CD's, DVD's, and the WWW.

Our venues are all available for public use as well. We have hosted, and will continue to host, many conferences, concerts, weddings, and high visibility memorial services/funerals.

Interference-free operations are critical to our operations so as to allow the free movement of our performance personnel on all of our stages, platforms, and performance spaces. The negatives that could come about with interference would be the resulting use of wires everywhere across performance spaces, walkways, aisles, and public areas.

We are asking the FCC to ensure that any rule change that the FCC adopts will allow our operators to obtain FCC wireless licenses and continue operating as we are now.
