REPLY COMMENTS

Nave Broadcasting, LLC (“Nave”), by its counsel, hereby submits its Reply Comments in response to the *Notice of Proposed Rule Making*, DA 09-2605 (rel. December 18, 2009), issued in the above-captioned rulemaking proceeding.

Nave previously stated its interest in and support of the proposed allotment of Channel 5 to Seaford, Delaware. Multiple parties, including Broadcast Maximization Committee (“BMC”), ABC, Inc. and Fox Television Stations, Inc., objected to the allotment of Channel 5 to Seaford because the proposed channel conflicted with their present or proposed use of that or an adjacent channel. It is Nave’s understanding that BMC will be proposing the use of Channel 3 in its Reply Comments. Nave would find Channel 3 at Seaford acceptable. The channel would still provide Seaford with an additional television service and result in the first commercial VHF allotment to the State of Delaware. If the allotment were made, Nave would apply for the channel and, if successful, would promptly construct its station after grant.




