On Friday, February 26, 2010, we submitted Frontier Communications Corp.'s ("Frontier") responses to the February 12, 2010 Information and Document Request in the above-referenced proceeding,¹ together with responsive documents. Two of the documents submitted in accordance with the procedures established in the Bureau's December 18, 2009 Protective Order² were produced in error with the designation of "Confidential." These two documents should have been withheld pending the conclusion of discussions with the Commission about whether they would be afforded Highly Confidential treatment. Upon conclusion of such discussions and, if appropriate, approval of such further protective order, Frontier anticipates promptly submitting these materials to the Commission.

Frontier also submits as Confidential an additional document that was omitted from Friday's production.

Accordingly, for convenience, we are submitting a corrected copy of Frontier's February 26, 2010 submission of Confidential documents, along with a corrected index, on the enclosed CDs. To avoid confusion and potential inadvertent release of Confidential or, if approved, Highly Confidential information, please destroy all copies of the CDs produced on February 26, 2010, and substitute the attached CDs. All other information on the CDs remains the same.
