Dear Ms. Dortch:

On March 2, 2010, Robert W. Quinn, Jr., Joan Marsh and Jeanine Poltronieri, representing AT&T met with Bruce Liang Gottlieb, Chief Counsel and Senior Legal Advisor to Chairman Genachowski and Ruth Milkman, Chief, Wireless Telecommunications Bureau. The purpose of the meeting was to discuss the roaming obligations of CMRS providers. The AT&T representatives expressed their views, consistent with AT&T's comments filed in this proceeding, that changes to the existing roaming rules are not needed and that voluntary negotiated roaming agreements continue to flourish. Specifically, elimination of the "home market" roaming exception would frustrate facilities-based competition and dis-incent build-out.
