Dear Ms. Dortch:

This is to advise you, in accordance with Section 1.1206 of the FCC's rules, that yesterday, March 3, 2010, George L. Mahoney, Vice President, Secretary, and General Counsel of Media General, Inc. ("Media General"), and I met with Commissioner Meredith Attwell Baker to discuss Media General's interest in the above-referenced dockets. Mr. Mahoney discussed broadcast industry initiatives involving multicasting and mobile DTV. Mr. Mahoney also presented concerns about spectrum options being reported as under consideration. He stated that a thorough inventory should be made of spectrum, that any proposals affecting broadcasters be wholly voluntary and not mandatory, and that broadcasters need to retain a full 6 MHz of spectrum, so each television station will have the ability to serve viewers in innovative ways.
