On March 3, 2010, Neville Ray, Peter Ewens, Tom Sugrue and the undersigned of T-Mobile USA, Inc. (“T-Mobile”), met with James Arden Barnett, David Furth, Jennifer Manner, and Jeffery Goldthorp, of the Public Safety and Homeland Security Bureau, to discuss a variety of issues of importance to the company.

During the meeting, the T-Mobile representatives provided their views on how to foster competitive choice in the development of a nationwide interoperable broadband network for public safety using the 700 MHz band. The representatives expressed T-Mobile’s support of Chairman Genachowski’s plan for public safety to access the entire 700 MHz band through roaming and priority access arrangements with commercial wireless carriers. The discussion was consistent with T-Mobile’s filings in the above-referenced dockets.
