**ORDER DISMISSING PROGRAM CARRIAGE COMPLAINT

NFL Enterprises LLC and Comcast Cable Communications LLC represent that new terms of an agreement for cable carriage have been achieved through negotiation, and that a dispositive agreement was executed on May 18, 2009.

Accordingly, IT IS ORDERED that Joint Motion to Dismiss Program Carriage Complaint with Prejudice and Terminate Proceeding filed on May 18, 2009 by Complainant NFL Enterprises LLC and Defendant Comcast Cable Communications LLC, IS GRANTED.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Program Carriage Complaint filed by NFL Enterprises LLC against Comcast Cable Communications LLC on May 6, 2008, IS DISMISSED WITH PREJUDICE.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the above-captioned proceeding is TERMINATED.<sup>1</sup>
