
Dear Ms. Dortch:

On March 5, 2010, representatives of Ericsson met with Admiral Jamie Barnett, Chief of the Commission's Public Safety and Homeland Security Bureau, David Furth, Deputy Bureau Chief, and Jennifer Manner, Deputy Bureau Chief to discuss the above mentioned proceeding. The following individuals were present on behalf of Ericsson: Doug Smith, Mark Racek, Barbara Baffer, and Patrik Ringqvist.

At the meeting, the Public Safety and Homeland Security Bureau outlined its plan to address Public Safety as part of the National Broadband Plan in four areas: Administration/Regulation, Interoperability, Funding, and Spectrum. The Bureau provided a high level summary of its plans for each of these areas. In addition, the parties discussed the Emergency Response Interoperability Center (ERIC). The parties also discussed the cost models and the assumptions made for modeling the networks and the Bureau provided an overview the funding that will be required to build public safety networks.
