

Ladies and Gentlemen:

Proceeding 07-293 raises the real and direct threat of causing crippling interference to SiriusXM's 35 million current listeners and the 90 million satellite radio-equipped vehicles that will share the road with mobile WCS by 2015.

\* It has been proven that WCS's usage models will cause interference to satellite radio consumers.

\* The staff proposal for WCS mobile transmitters in the C and D blocks — the blocks immediately adjacent to satellite radio's satellites — will double the power levels the WCS licensees themselves asked for, and would exceed the levels the WCS licensees themselves demonstrated in Ashburn, Virginia.

\* This entire process presumes that consumers would complain instead of just discontinuing their subscriptions. I beg to differ. Consumers, in this case, will not wait for relief. Instead they will cancel subscriptions until, if ever, the problem is remedied. The fact is that any such cumbersome, after-the-fact remedy system would not work to protect consumers and would place the Commission in the impossible role of policing interference to all of our subscribers, of those that remain.

\* Satellite radio itself would be severely compromised by 07-293; it would harm the company, via these interference actions threatened to be allowed and promulgated by the FCC, to the point of causing satellite radio again to consider resorting to bankruptcy; in other words, these unreasonable and unnecessary actions would directly threaten the survival of satellite radio service for North America.
