This is to notify you that on March 9, 2010, I spoke by telephone with Rosemary Harold, Legal Advisor to Commissioner Robert McDowell, regarding CEA's position on National Broadband Public Notice #27.

During our discussion, I expressed CEA's longstanding view that the objectives of Section 629 have never been fully realized. At last, NBP #27 seeks to achieve a robust marketplace for video devices. In addition to the positions set forth in CEA's comments submitted on December 21, 2009, I urged the Commission to issue a Notice of Proposed Rulemaking (NPRM) so that all interested parties may provide direct, meaningful, and actionable input. I also urged the Commission to adopt firm deadlines by which any rules resulting from the proceeding must be enacted.
