In accordance with Section 1.1206 of the Commission's rules, 47 C.F.R. § 1.1206, this letter notifies the Commission that on March 11, 2010 I spoke to John Giusti, Chief of Staff and Legal Advisor to Commissioner Copps, on behalf of Sirius XM Radio Inc. ("Sirius XM"). During the conversation I expressed the views of Sirius XM that have previously been submitted into the record of the above-captioned proceeding. Specifically, I reiterated the views that Sirius XM expressed during the March 2, 2010 meeting between Sirius XM, WCS licensees, and FCC engineering staff related to a potential resolution of the issues surrounding WCS service rules. Those views are reflected in Sirius XM's March 3, 2010 *ex parte* disclosure filed in this docket. Additionally, I repeated the views of Sirius XM as detailed in the *ex parte* letters sent by Sirius XM CEO Mel Karmazin to the Commissioners on March 4, a copy of which has been previously submitted to this docket.
