During this meeting, Iowa Health discussed the importance of rural broadband infrastructure to promote rural health care, the limited funding to date of rural healthcare broadband infrastructure under the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act of 2009, and additional opportunities for funding of rural broadband infrastructure to support expanded rural health care initiatives under the Commission's National Broadband Plan.


