Dear Dr. Smith:

On November 16, 2009, the International Bureau released an order in the above-captioned proceeding that requires that all facilities-based carriers subject to Commission jurisdiction having an operating agreement with Digicel Tonga Limited (Digicel) for direct termination of U.S. traffic on the U.S.-Tonga route to suspend all termination payments to Digicel for switched voice service.¹ Information provided in the above-captioned proceeding indicates that Digicel USA has arrangements that appear subject to the restrictions specified in the Bureau's order.
