Dear Ms. Dortch:

On March 23, 2010, Thomas Sugrue, Neville Ray, Dirk Mosa, Michael Amend, Mark McDiarmid and the undersigned of T-Mobile USA, Inc. ("T-Mobile") met with James Barnett and Jennifer Manner of the Public Safety and Homeland Security Bureau; James Schlichting and John Leibovitz of the Wireless Telecommunications Bureau; and Tom Peters of the Office of Strategic Planning and Policy Analysis, regarding the above-captioned proceedings. On March 24, 2010, Mr. Sugrue, Mr. Ray, Cole Brodman, Peter Ewens, and the undersigned met with Edward Lazarus, chief of staff to Chairman Genachowski, and Blair Levin, executive director of the Omnibus Broadband Initiative, regard these proceedings.

In the meetings, the T-Mobile participants explained that there is an immediate and substantial demand for additional mobile broadband spectrum in order to promote jobs, growth, and competition, and discussed T-Mobile's interest in obtaining additional spectrum to expand its broadband wireless offerings. They expressed support for the spectrum recommendations in the National Broadband Plan, including auctioning the D Block for commercial use; reallocating spectrum from the broadcast television band; and having NTIA complete an analysis by October 1, 2010 of the possibility of reallocating a portion of the 1755-1850 MHz band from federal to non-federal use to pair with the AWS-3 band. They also outlined T-Mobile's proposal for incentive based partnerships with public safety that would provide public safety with access to the D Block and other spectrum in the 700 MHz band, as described in T-Mobile's prior filings in these dockets.

Pursuant to section 1.1206(b) of the Commission's rules, an electronic copy of this letter is being filed electronically with the Office of the Secretary for inclusion in the above-referenced dockets and served electronically on the Commission participants in the meeting.
