Dear Ms. Dortch:

On March 23, 2010, representatives of US Cellular (Leroy T. Carlson, Jr. – Chairman of the Board; Steve Campbell – Executive Vice President & CFO; John Gockley – Vice President – Legal & Regulatory Affairs; Jeff Baenke – Sr. Director- Technology Development; Grant Spellmeyer – Director – Legislative & Regulatory Affairs; and Joe Hanley – Vice President – Technology Planning & Services for Telephone & Data Systems, Inc.) met with John Leibovitz – Deputy Chief of the Wireless Bureau and Tom Peters – Director, Wireless Engineering – National Broadband Task Force to discuss spectrum related provisions of the National Broadband Plan (“NBP”).

During the course of the discussion US Cellular representatives:

- Expressed support for many of the spectrum related provisions of the NBP.
- Advocated for the creation of small license blocks (EA, CMA, etc) for any subsequent auctions of spectrum.
- Expressed an interest in participating in a future auction of AWS spectrum
- Expressed support for the NBP recommendation for a commercial auction of the D-Block and a desire to work with public safety agencies on the establishment of interoperability and roaming arrangements.
- Expressed a desire that the FCC pursue pair spectrum allocations whenever possible.
