On March 23, 2010, the undersigned and Ultratec & CapTel employees Rob Engelke, Kevin Colwell, and Jayne Turner met with Christine Kurth, Policy Director & Wireline Counsel for Commissioner McDowell, Christi Shewman, Legal Advisor for Wireline for Commissioner Atwell Baker, Commissioner Mignon Clyburn and her Legal Advisor, Angela Kroenburg, and Jennifer Schneider, Sr. Policy Advisor & Legal Counsel for Wireline for Commissioner Copps to discuss the pending proceeding wherein the Commission is considering a rulemaking to address mandatory captioned telephone service (“CTS”).

Specifically, Ultratec updated the Commission on the latest status of this technology and answered questions raised by recent submissions on this subject. The points raised by Ultratec in this *ex parte* communication track Ultratec's reply comments filed in this docket on July 27, 2009. In addition, discussion of the attached document was held.
