On Friday, March 26, 2010, Patrick Sullivan of the Telecommunications Industry Association (TIA) met with Ms. Nese Guendelsberger, Division Chief, Spectrum & Competition Policy Division (SCPD) of the Wireless Telecommunications Bureau (WTB); Mr. Peter Trachtenberg, Associate Chief, Competition Policy, SCPD; Mr. Ziad Sleem, Associate Chief, Technical Policy, SCPD; Ms. Nicole McGinnis, SCPD; Mr. Ty M. Bream, Attorney Advisor, SCPD; Mr. Sharif Shahrier, Engineer, WTB; and Mr. Michael C. Smith, Program Analyst, SCPD.

In this meeting, Mr. Sullivan noted that TIA members believe that any local entity seeking to build out an interoperable broadband public safety network should be required to follow the interoperability requirements of the National Public Safety Telecommunications Council's Broadband Task Force as an initial set of minimum standards that must be augmented or altered to comply with the interoperability requirements the Emergency Response Interoperability Center later determines necessary for the deployment of a nationwide public safety broadband network.
