
Interference-free operations (per our wireless systems) are essential to our weekly services and also to our large drama/musical productions that draw 8,000 people in a week. Our Easter Pageant has a 31-year tradition in our small city of 85,000. Our mayor is a musician in the production.

We are asking that any changes in the FCC regulations regarding use of wireless mic frequencies allows us to obtain a wireless microphone license and continue doing what we are currently doing in using wireless mics.
