Dear Ms. Dortch,

On Monday March 29, 2010 Andrew Jay Schwartzman of Media Access Project, Corie Wright and Ben Scott of Free Press, and Angela Campbell, Adrienne Biddings, and Frank Balsamello of the Institute for Public Representation—collectively Public Interest Advocates—met with Commissioner Copps and his Media Advisor, Joshua Cinelli.

The Public Interest Advocates urged the Commission to act promptly on outstanding petitions for reconsideration relating to the 2006 Quadrennial Review and subsequent 2008 Order. The parties pointed out that because the Third Circuit has lifted the stay and allowed the revised newspaper-cross-ownership rule to take effect, it is important that the FCC give prominent public notice of any waiver requests.

The Public Interest Advocates also urged the Commission to separate the online public file requirement from the Form 355 requirement in the *Enhanced Disclosure* proceeding. Finally, the Public Interest Advocates called for the Commission to address petitions for reconsideration relating to enhanced disclosure and to promptly implement the online public file.
