On March 9, 2010, Cellco Partnership d/b/a Verizon Wireless (“Verizon Wireless”) and AT&T Inc. (“AT&T” and, collectively with Verizon Wireless, the “Applicants”) filed a Request for a Second Protective Order in the above-referenced proceeding to provide heightened or second level protection for certain categories of highly sensitive competitive information that have been requested by the FCC in the General Information Request received by the Applicants on November 19, 2009, to which responses are due to be filed today.

Verizon Wireless understands that this request is still under consideration by the Wireless Telecommunications Bureau. Earlier today, counsel for Verizon Wireless spoke by telephone with Susan Singer of the Wireless Telecommunications Bureau, indicating that Verizon Wireless would prefer that all pending protective order issues be resolved before it submits any highly confidential materials to the FCC to ensure that the appropriate protection will be provided when the information is filed. Accordingly, Verizon Wireless requests that it be given until three business days following grant of the Applicants’ request for a Second Protective Order in this proceeding to provide written responses to the General Information Request.
