Dear Ms. Dortch:

This is to advise that the undersigned, representing the Aerospace and Flight Test Radio Coordinating Council ("AFTRCC") has spoken by phone with Richard Arsenault, Chief Counsel, Wireless Telecommunications Bureau, regarding AFTRCC's request for confidential treatment of the precise locations of aeronautical mobile telemetry receive sites.

AFTRCC's representative urged that disclosure of this information to the world via ECFS was inappropriate, given the security measures with which aerospace companies and Government test authorities protect these facilities; and unnecessary, in that alternative means are available to ensure that interested parties with a need-to-know can be afforded access to the data. Mr. Arsenault and the undersigned also discussed the possibility of supplementing AFTRCC's request in the context of the above.
