On April 6, 2010, Joan Marsh, Jeanine Poltronieri and Terri Hoskins, representing AT&T, met with David Goldman of the Office of Chairman Julius Genachowski. The purpose of the meeting was to discuss the roaming obligations of CMRS providers. The AT&T representatives expressed AT&T's views, consistent with AT&T's comments filed in this proceeding, that changes to the existing roaming rules are not needed and that voluntary negotiated roaming agreements continue to flourish. Specifically, elimination of the "home market" roaming exception would frustrate facilities-based competition and dis-incent build-out.
