**REQUEST FOR EXTENSION OF TIME TO FILE REPLY COMMENTS**

The Open Internet Coalition (“OIC”)<sup>1</sup> respectfully requests that the Federal Communications Commission extend the time for filing comments in the above referenced dockets.

Our request comes as a result of the April 6, 2010 United States Court of Appeals for the District of Columbia Circuit decision in *Comcast v. Federal Communications Commission*. This decision spoke directly to the issue of the Commission’s use of ancillary authority to discipline Comcast Corporation for engaging in certain network management practices. This use of such authority is cited in the above referenced dockets, and the court’s decision puts into question the legal foundation on which the proposed rules are based.

Ultimately, we believe that the Commission has the authority to promulgate rules that will protect consumers. In light of the court’s decision, however, we request additional time to incorporate and respond to the decision’s
