On Wednesday, April 7, 2010 Andrew Jay Schwartzman and Tyrone Brown of Media Access Project, Counsel for Prometheus Radio Project, Corie Wright of Free Press, and Angela Campbell, Adrienne Biddings, and Robert Lepore of the Institute for Public Representation, Counsel for Media Alliance and Common Cause, met with Commissioner Mignon Clyburn and her Chief of Staff, Rick Kaplan.

The parties urged the Commission to act promptly on Common Cause's outstanding petition for reconsideration relating to the 2006 Quadrennial Review and subsequent 2008 Order. The parties pointed out that because the Third Circuit has lifted the stay and allowed the revised newspaper-cross-ownership rule to take effect, it is important that the FCC give prominent public notice of any waiver requests.

The parties also urged the Commission to move forward on pending minority and female ownership matters. In particular, the Public Interest Advocate urged the Commission to complete implementation of revised Form 323 so that the Commission could begin collecting the data necessary to assess the state of minority and female ownership. The Public Interest Advocates argued that relaxation of the ownership rules significantly affect the level of minority and female ownership, and the implementation of Form 323 will provide the Commission the data necessary to consider those effects as it moves forward.
