**Re: The Boeing Company; Support for Request for Additional Time to File Comments;
WT Docket No. 07-293 and IB Docket No. 95-91**

Dear Ms. Dortch:

The Boeing Company (“Boeing”), through its attorneys, hereby expresses its support for the Sirius XM Radio Inc. (“Sirius XM”) Request for Additional Time to File Comments¹ on the Commission’s Public Notice requesting comment on the draft interference rules for the wireless communications service and satellite digital audio radio service.²

As stated in the filings of the Aerospace and Flight Test Radio Coordinating Council (“AFTRCC”) and recognized by the Commission in the Public Notice, this proceeding has an important impact on the Aeronautical Mobile Telemetry (“AMT”) receive sites operated by the flight test community, including Boeing. Some of the proposed rules are novel to Boeing, including the specific out of band emissions limits proposed for the frequencies surrounding the 2360-2395 MHz band and the appropriate application of the proposed coordination requirements to protect Boeing’s mobile AMT test vehicles. Boeing has not commented on these specific issues previously and requires a reasonable amount of time to consider them.


