

Dear Ms. Dortch:

On April 8, 2010, I met with Rick Kaplan, Chief of Staff for Commissioner Mignon Clyburn. At the meeting, we discussed Charter Communications' ("Charter") position on the recommendation in the National Broadband Plan concerning a rulemaking proceeding to address certain issues related to CableCARDS. Charter advocated that limiting the use of one-way high definition digital terminal adapters ("DTAs") to small cable systems would be inconsistent with the Commission's broadband goals and urged the Commission to permit all cable systems to utilize such limited DTAs, in light of marketplace changes and consistent with the Commission's goals.
