On April 9, 2010, Victor Tawil and Bruce Franca of the Association for Maximum Service Television (MSTV) met with Mr. Julius Knapp, Mr. Alan Stillwell, Mr. Ira Keltz, Mr. Ron Repasi, Mr. Bruce Romano, Ms. Geraldine Matise, and Mr. Rod Small of the Office of Engineering and Technology (OET). Dr. Rashmi Doshi of OET's Laboratory Division attended the meeting by video conference.

MSTV discussed the timing of the above Commission proceedings. MSTV reviewed its proposals with regard to unlicensed operations on TV White Spaces and the establishment of an FCC/industry committee to facilitate approval and oversight of devices, databases and database providers.

MSTV also reviewed its proposal for addressing wireless microphones. MSTV pointed out that the current proposal to create a new category of Part 15 devices is technically unsound and unworkable. MSTV pointed out that expanding Part 74 eligibility was the only solution supported by every wireless microphone user and is the best solution to ensure that the spectrum is being used most efficiently and most effectively.
