All testing on the WCS services was performed at a bandwidth of 5 MHz, and yet your propsal allows the WCS members to exceed those limits, without testing, instead calling the aggregation of spectrum "unlikely". It was also said how unlikely it was for a service designed to perform two-way video chat applications, yet Sirius XM demonstrated the use of one of those applications on April 5th. Unlikely happens, and it needs to be taken into account by your staff.

Your job as public servants is to protect the people. There are nearly 19 million people that pay for Satellite Radio ever montha and growing on a daily basis. There are 35+ million people who listen to Satellite Radio on a daily basis. (By the way - Arbitron said that these people are also wealthier, more highly educated, and more intelligent than the average radio listener. Probably more likely to vote as well). There are even more millions that depend and count on safe air travel on a daily basis. Your proposal would put every single one of those people in jepordy.
