

Dear Ladies and Gentlemen of the Commission,

In my 09 April 2010 submission, I made an error when I stated:

" (3) I support the premise of limiting non-individuals (clubs) to having only ONE callsign per entity under any circumstance. "

This statement should have read:

(3) I support the premise of limiting non-individuals (clubs) to having ONE VANITY callsign per entity under any circumstance."

Indeed, other correspondents have made an effective argument for the issuance of additional callsigns for clubs, especially where said club operates multiple repeaters, linear translators, digital nodes, D-STAR systems, etc.

However I would respectfully suggest that the Commission open the previously restricted "WK" 2-by-3 callsign block (ie: WK4ABC) that it previous proposed for club callsigns, and issue these calls to clubs in a sequential, non-preferred manner.

Furthermore, I would recommend that said "secondary" station licenses be annotated on the club's primary grant under the "Special Conditions and Endorsements" block. This would greatly reduce the administrative burden for both clubs and the Commission.

I apologize for the above administrative error on my part.
