U.S. TelePacific Corp. d/b/a TelePacific Communications (“TelePacific” or “Company”), pursuant to Section 1.1206(b) of the Commission’s Rules, *47 CFR §1.1206(b)*, provides supplemental information concerning the impact on the Company of the *USAC Decision Letter*. Certain information contained in this letter is confidential and proprietary information that, if subject to public disclosure, would cause significant commercial and competitive harm to TelePacific. TelePacific has requested confidential treatment of this information by separate letter.

When TelePacific filed its Petition for Stay and Request for Review and Reversal of the *USAC Decision Letter*, it provided five estimates of potential USF liability in Mr. Forgo’s Declaration. Although the five scenarios varied based on how one interpreted the *USAC Decision Letter*, each included a “LD private line reclass” component that did not vary because it reclassified long distance private line revenue that was not related to broadband Internet access revenue. Forgo Declaration, ¶14. TelePacific has determined that Attachment 2 (and the corresponding citations to it) included reclassified private line revenue rather than the *USF contribution* impact of reclassifying that revenue and
