
Dear Ms. Dortch:

On April 13, 2010, representatives of Ericsson met with FCC Staff from the Public Safety and Homeland Security Bureau and Office of Engineering and Technology including: Jennifer Manner, Stagg Newman, Jon Peha, Robert Weller, Brian Hurley, Pat Amodio, and Walter Johnston to discuss the above mentioned proceeding. The group discussed the Public Safety and Homeland Security Bureau's objectives for a Public Safety Broadband Wireless Network to provide 21st Century Communications for First Responders

At the meeting, the Public Safety and Homeland Security Bureau outlined its assumptions for the Cost Models for a Public Safety Broadband Wireless Network and described their vision for a reliable, high coverage, mission critical network. In addition, the group discussed Interoperability, Roaming, Priority Access, and the D-Block.
