This is to inform you that on Wednesday, April 14, 2010, the undersigned, on behalf of Leap Wireless International and Cricket Communications (“together, Cricket”), had separate telephonic conversations with Ruth Milkman, Chief of the Wireless Telecommunications Bureau (“WTB”) and James Schlichting, Senior Deputy Chief of the WTB.

During these conversations, Cricket summarized its meetings with various Commissioners’ offices and reiterated its support for the elimination of the in-market roaming exception, as set forth in its filings in the above-referenced proceeding.
