Telephone USA Investments, Inc. ("Telephone USA"), by its counsel, submits this letter to report that on April 19, 2010, Joseph A. Stroud, principal of Telephone USA, spoke with Louis Peraertz, Acting Legal Advisor, Wireless, International and Public Safety to Commissioner Mignon Clyburn, regarding the above-referenced proceedings. In the telephone conversation, Mr. Stroud reviewed the issues covered in Telephone USA's previous filings in this matter, including the letter of April 15, 2010.

Mr. Stroud noted the continued willingness of Telephone USA to work with Verizon Wireless in attempting to resolve the difficulties faced by small businesses in their efforts to acquire wireless properties, which were noted by the FCC in its November, 2008 decision approving Verizon Wireless' acquisition of Alltel. Mr. Stroud explained that Telephone USA entered into discussions with Verizon Wireless at that company's invitation and remains eager to work to open the door to small businesses and new entrants to the wireless industry. Telephone USA believes that this is the right time for such discussions to lead to tangible results.
