I think that Web pages posted by "astroturf" lobbying groups like Public Knowledge -- which "spam" many dockets at the FCC to such an extent that one has to employ filters to get to the substantive comments -- are a travesty. No cellular provider is being unreasonable with regard to its text messaging policy. In fact, companies like Sprint are being responsible when they work to prevent fraud and spam. What we need to do now is prevent lobbyists like Public Knowledge -- who masquerade as "public interest" groups but in reality lobby for large corporations such as Google -- from spamming the public record.
