
**Re: *Ex Parte* Notice, *Preserving the Open Internet*, GN Docket No. 09-191**

Dear Ms. Dortch:

On April 19, 2010, Darcy Antonellis, President of Warner Bros. Technical Operations; John Rogovin, Executive Vice President and General Counsel of Warner Bros. Entertainment, Inc. ("Warner Bros."); Carol Melton, Executive Vice President, Global Public Policy, of Time Warner Inc.; and the undersigned had two separate meetings with (1) Priya Aiyar, Legal Advisor to Chairman Genachowski; Austin Schlick, General Counsel; William Lake, Chief of the Media Bureau; and Zachary Katz, Deputy Chief of the Office of Strategic Planning and Policy Analysis; and (2) John Peha, Chief Technologist; Walter Johnston and James Miller of the Office of Engineering and Technology; and Saurbh Chhabra of the Wireless Telecommunications Bureau.

During the first meeting, Ms. Antonellis described the many new and innovative digital business models that Warner Bros. is rapidly embracing, including those on broadband networks, to enable broader distribution of its creative works. She and Mr. Rogovin explained the important role that quality of service plays in meeting consumer expectations for such services, stressed the need for flexibility in this regard, and inquired as to how proposals in the above-referenced docket might impact efforts to ensure consumers' expectations are met. In the second meeting, Ms. Antonellis continued the earlier discussion of quality of service considerations, and described international efforts to combat content piracy consistent with comments previously filed by the Motion Picture Association of America in the above-referenced docket.
