On Thursday, April 22, 2010 Professor Angela Campbell, Adrienne Biddings, and Robert Lepore of the Institute for Public Representation, Counsel for Media Alliance and Common Cause; Andrew Jay Schwartzman of Media Access Project, Counsel for Prometheus Radio Project; and Corie Wright of Free Press and met with Jacob Lewis, James Carr, and Daniel Armstrong, of the Office of General Counsel, and Sarah Whitesell, Marcia Glauber, and Amy Brett, of the Media Bureau.

The parties urged the Commission to act promptly on Common Cause's outstanding petition for reconsideration relating to the 2006 Quadrennial Review and subsequent 2008 Order. In particular, the parties pointed out that because the Third Circuit has lifted the stay and allowed the revised newspaper-broadcast cross-ownership rule to take effect, it is important that the FCC give prominent public notice of any waiver requests. In addition, the parties argued that the Commission should act promptly to fix loopholes in the waiver standards for the revised newspaper-broadcast cross-ownership rule.
