("AGL-Parent") (collectively, the "Applicants") and in response to a request from staff, this letter provides supplemental information regarding AGLN's state authorizations to provide telecommunications services. Specifically, Applicants clarify that AGLN is authorized to provide intrastate (local exchange, interexchange and/or private line) telecommunications services in Arizona, Georgia, Missouri, Nevada and North Carolina. As stated in the Application, AGLN provides dark fiber in Georgia, North Carolina, Missouri, Virginia and Arizona. AGLN does not provide lit telecommunications services in any state.
