On April 22, 2010, Lawrence Alder and the undersigned of Google Inc. met with Julius Knapp, Alan Stillwell, Ira Keltz, Walter Johnston, and Bruce Romano of the Federal Communications Commission's Office of Engineering and Technology regarding the above-captioned proceedings. Mr. Alder and I noted with approval the Commission's dedication to preserving unlicensed use of the TV white spaces in the National Broadband Plan, and we expressed Google's support for the recent Public Notice indicating that the FCC would complete action in the white spaces proceeding later this year. We also urged the Commission to commence the process of selecting multiple white spaces geolocation database administrators as soon as possible and discussed Google's continued interest in serving as a database administrator. Finally, Mr. Alder and I provided an update on the progress of the Google Fiber for Communities initiative, including the ongoing review of submitted applications.
