Dear Ms. Dortch:

Yesterday, Elaine Critides of Verizon Wireless, Tamara Preiss of Verizon, and Lynn Charytan of WilmerHale met with Albert Lewis and Lynn Engledow of the Wireline Competition Bureau, Peter Trachtenberg of the Wireless Telecommunications Bureau, and Chris Killion and Diane Holland of the Office of General Counsel to discuss the impact of the Commission's decision in *North County Communications*¹ on compensation arrangements between wireless providers and competitive local exchange carriers (CLECs) for intraMTA traffic. These include a spike in proceedings before state public utility commissions (including at least one in which the CLEC is seeking to impose intrastate access charges for this traffic), litigation in state and federal courts, rampant uncertainty, and increased opportunities and incentives for CLECs to engage in traffic pumping arbitrage schemes. We discussed different procedural vehicles that offer an opportunity for the FCC to address these issues, including the above-referenced proceedings.
